Safety Tips

1. Removal and installation of suspension springs may be dangerous. Please use a reputable and qualified licensed mechanic with experienced in installing suspension springs. Installation includes hazards from dynamics such as, springs under compression are likely to “jump”, striking nearby persons or objects. We also recommend that your Swift products be installed by a dealer with experience in maintaining and repair of the specific type of vehicle in which the Swift products are to be installed.

2. Always Use Jack Stands, Locking Lift, or other properly functioning equipment designed for the purpose of safely supporting the weight of a vehicle while people work underneath it. **NO ONE SHOULD EVER WORK UNDER A VEHICLE SUPPORTED ONLY WITH A JACK!** When re-installing, (if necessary) all parts should be cleaned, examined and replaced. Upon completion, all nuts, bolts must be tightened to the factory torque settings. Upon completion of installation/reinstallation (if necessary) the vehicle should be visually examined and checked to verify all components are present and in correct location and in proper functional condition.

3. Use your Swift products **ONLY** on the vehicle it was designed for! Installation and/or usage of the Swift products not designed for your vehicle may result in personal injury or property damage. If you are unsure about suitability to your application, please contact a reputable and qualified licensed mechanic with experienced in installing suspension products.

4. Some vehicles may have certain accessories or features which require inspection and/or adjustment after installation of Swift products. The qualified mechanic installing the Swift products should also inspect and where necessary, adjust:

Self-leveling system, if your car is so equipped.

Wheel alignment such as camber, caster, toe in and toe out (may need additional components that require additional purchase)

The sensors on your brake anti-locking or anti-skid system

Tire and/or fender clearance

Brake line clearance and attachment

Failure to adjust these items may result in malfunction and voiding of the Limited 3 year warranty.

5. Swift products may change the way vehicle drives, especially through curves. Drive slowly to until you (original purchaser) become comfortable and aware of the new driving/handling characteristics of the vehicle.

6. In certain circumstances, changes in the way the vehicle handles, drives or rides may indicate that the Swift products have not been correctly installed, have become displaced, or require replacement. If the vehicle does not provide a smooth ride, is not “level” when parked on a level surface, becomes miss-aligned or, vibrates at highway speeds, you (original purchaser) should have it inspected by a reputable qualified licensed mechanic with experience in installation of suspension components. Continued use of defective or misfit of Swift products could result in personal injury or property damage and may void the limited 3 year warranty.

7. Your (the original purchaser) Swift products have been thoroughly tested, designed, and undergone the strictest of quality assurance. However, **ALL PRODUCTS CAN BREAK** under extreme circumstances that was unintended. To prevent damage or failure, suspension components should not be subjected to:

Undue strain caused by using vehicle on race tracks, off-road conditions, or continued use on poorly maintained or improperly maintained roads.

Undue stress caused by abnormal sharp and/or quick maneuvering or steering.

Excessive speed: maximum legal speed should be observed at all times and never exceeded.

Excessive weight: please refer to the maximum vehicle manufacture suggested loads, these limitations should be observed at all times and never exceeded.
